***** CONDITIONS OF ENTRY *****

1. Tournament is conducted under the rules of Play and Code of Ethics as contained in the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council Handbook (and amendments).
2. Junior players will be accepted, subject to normal Club rules and regulations being observed.
3. Tournament will be a singles format with individual handicaps allocated for all players. Play will be at 2 venues on Saturday 26th, Mingara Recreation Club at Tumbi Umbi and Newcastle Snooker Club at Broadmeadow with all play in Sunday 27th at Mingara Recreation Club.
4. Handicaps are allocated at the SBCC Board's discretion, and may be altered up to and including the 2nd round.
5. A revised 'Foul and a Miss' rule applies to all matches as shown on SBCC website

6. A 'Mercy Rule' will be imposed on all frames as shown on SBCC website

7. Matches are all best of three (3) frames, until semi-finals and Final which are best of five (5) frames.
8. High break 'handicapped' will be the value of a minimum 4 balls potted + set handicap
9. The "Central Coast Challenge" Tournament is a special two-day event, with play scheduled as follows:
Saturday: all preliminary games down to the quarter-finals; Sunday: quarter finals, semi-finals and Final.
(subject to scheduling)
10. Competition is a "knock-out" event. **All losing players MUST mark the next available game.**
11. **Dress regulations** : SBCC Dress Code applies and is the MINIMUM accepted as shown on SBCC website
<http://snookerccc.com/uploads/policies/2026-Dress-Code.pdf>. Anyone failing to meet this minimum standard will not be permitted to play.
12. **Entries close last mail on Wednesday 17th September 2026 at 5:00pm.**
13. Draw will be made public on the SBCC Facebook page no later than Monday 21st September and all players will be notified by email of their approximate starting times.
14. **NOTE** : All players will be required to check in with Tournament Director at their venue at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled commencement time of their game. **Any player not in attendance when called to commence their game will forfeit the first frame immediately and after 15 minutes, the match.**
15. **Tournament (SBCC) Board decisions will be final in all instances.**
