## \*\*\*CONDITIONS OF ENTRY\*\*\*

- 1. Tournament is conducted under the rules of Play and Code of Ethics as contained in the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council Handbook (and amendments).
- 2. Junior players will be accepted, subject to normal Club rules and regulations being observed.
- 3. Tournament will be a singles format with individual handicaps allocated for all players.
- 4. All handicaps will be allocated at the SBCC Board's discretion, and may be altered up to and including the 2<sup>nd</sup> round.
- 5. All preliminary games will be best of three (3) frames, quarter finals, semi-finals and Final all best of five (5) frames.
- 6. The "Cueing For Kids" Tournament is a special two-day event, with play scheduled as follows: Saturday: all preliminary games down to the quarter-finals; Sunday: quarter finals, semi-finals and Final.
- 7. Competition is a "knock-out" event. All losing players MUST mark the next available game.
- 8. **Dress regulations :** Tournament dress is optional. A minimum standard of neat and tidy dress will be required on BOTH DAYS ie: **dress pants, collared shirt and enclosed dress shoes**. **DEFINITELY NO JEANS, JOGGERS, SANDALS OR OPEN-TOED SHOES**
- 9. Entries close last mail on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019 at 5:00pm.
- 10. All players will be allocated a starting time for first round games, which can be obtained by contacting a member of the SBCC Board (names and phone numbers listed below) any time on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July **but no later than 9.00 pm**.
- 11. <u>NOTE</u>: All players will be required to check in with Tournament officials at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled commencement time of their game. <u>Any player not in attendance when called to commence their game will forfeit the first frame immediately. Should the player be 15 minutes late then he/she will forfeit the game.</u>
- 12. Tournament (SBCC) Board decisions will be final in all instances.
