HANDICAPPED SNOOKER TOURNAMENT

<u>CONDITIONS OF ENTRY</u>*

- 1. Tournament is conducted under the rules of Play and Code of Ethics as contained in the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council Handbook (and amendments)
- 2. Junior players will be accepted, subject to normal Club rules and regulations being observed.
- 3. Tournament will be a singles format with individual handicaps allocated for all players
- 4. All handicaps will be allocated at the SBCC Board's discretion, and may be altered up to and including the 2nd round
- 5. A revised "Foul and a Miss" rule is imposed on games and players, refer rule at <u>https://snookercc.com/uploads/policies/foul-and-a-miss.pdf</u>
- 6. A "Mercy Rule" will be imposed on all frames <u>https://snookercc.com/uploads/policies/mercy-rule.pdf</u>
- 7. All preliminary and quarter final games will be best of three (3) frames then semi-finals and Final will be best of five (5) frames
- 8. High break "handicapped" will be the value of a minimum 4 balls potted + set handicap
- 9. The "*Cueing for Kids*" Tournament is a special two-day event, with play scheduled as follows: <u>Saturday</u>: all preliminary games down to the quarter-finals; <u>Sunday</u>: quarter finals, semi-finals and Final
- 10. Competition is a "knock-out" event
- 11. All losing players MUST mark the next available game or be fined \$15 (to charity)
- 12. Dress regulations: Dress pants/trousers, Dress Shoes, Collared Shirt or Representing Club Shirt, Tournament dress is optional. <u>DEFINITELY NO JEANS, JOGGERS, SPORTS/TRACK</u> <u>CLOTHING, SANDALS OR OPEN-TOED SHOES</u>
- 13. Entries must be received by email no later than Wednesday 27th August 2025
- 14. All players will be allocated a starting time for first round games which will be posted on SBCC Facebook page and emailed to entrants if email address provided, otherwise it's your responsibility to be present at the club from 9:30am Saturday 30th August.
- 15. All players will be required to check in with Tournament officials at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled commencement time of their game
- 16. Any player not in attendance when called to commence their game will forfeit the first frame immediately, any player not present to play 15 minutes after scheduled will forfeit the game
 17. SDCC and the Tourner principal decisions will be final in all instances
- 17. SBCC and the Tournament Director decisions will be final in all instances
