TUESDAY NIGHT “SUMMER BILLIARDS” TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT – 2023/24

1. TEAMS

- a. Only member clubs are eligible enter teams
- b. Players must be financial members of the nominating Billiards & Snooker Club
- c. Players must be financial members of SBCC prior to playing and renew membership if due during the competition
- d. All players must remain financial members of nominating club to be eligible to play
- e. A player cannot be transferred from another team once they have played a game for another team

2. PLAYING FORMAT

- a. A competition round will be scheduled each Tuesday night (excluding Public Holidays and other special events)
- b. All teams will compete in a round robin home & away format for the preliminary rounds
- c. Each player will compete in a “points up” game (NOT TIMED)
 - i. Players off all/any grade can compete as they only need to score their graded target score:

GRADE	POINTS TARGET	3 POINTS 100%	2 POINTS 90%	1 POINT 80%

- d. Players
 - i. Three (3) compete each round (match)
 - ii. Each game will be points up target based on grade
 - iii. All 3 games will be contested each round
 - iv. A player cannot contest 2 games against the same opponent
- e. Forfeits
 - i. Two (2) players are required to constitute a match
 - ii. If a player forfeits the opposing player will be awarded the game win (3 game points)
 - iii. If a team forfeits points will be awarded equal to the maximum points earned by any other team for that round
- f. Commencement of games
 - i. Three (3) games must start at 6:30pm
 - ii. Home team captain to determine order of play and tables allocation during the preliminary rounds
 - iii. SBCC official will determine order of play and table allocation for all finals matches
 - iv. If any player is not present to start the game as scheduled a fifty (50) point penalty is to be applied immediately and awarded to the opponent
 - v. If any game isn't started within 30 minutes the game will be forfeited
- g. Competition points will be awarded as follows:
 - i. Each game will be contested for game points
 - 1. Winner 3 points
 - 2. Loser (scoring 90%+ of their target score score) 2 points
 - 3. Loser (scoring 80%+ of their target score score) 1 point
 - ii. One (1) point bonus for compliance of preliminary round dress code
 - iii. The team winning the most game points will be deemed the match winner
- h. The Home team captain is responsible for:
 - i. Game scores must be recorded
 - ii. The score sheet must be filled out neatly and legible to the recorder to read
 - iii. Results MUST be text to the recorder 0404 553 043 on the evening of the match, Email a Copy/Scan/Photograph of the official team sheet to the recorder within 24 hours of match results@snookercc.com
- i. Venue Closures:
 - i. In the event a game cannot be finished due to the forceful completion and/or exiting a venue due to playing exceeding the venue trading hours the frame (snooker) or game (billiards) will be awarded to the visiting player.

3. HANDICAPPING/GRADING

- i. Handicaps are not win/loss fluctuating on a game/round basis
- ii. Players may play in any order regardless of handicap
- iii. Captains are responsible to record the correct grade & target score when listing your team, penalties apply for playing the incorrect grade

- iv. Player Grading may be reviewed at 1/3 and 2/3 completion of the competition
- v. SBCC makes every effort to ensure all players are handicapped correctly, however in the interest of fair play may at any time adjust a player's handicap.

4. PLAYING RULES

- a. Rules will apply to all games as per the OFFICIAL RULE BOOK of the AUSTRALIAN BILLIARDS & SNOOKER COUNCIL (Nov 2019 Handbook) and are to be observed at all times

5. FINALS

- a. A finals competition will follow the preliminary rounds
- b. Refer to the SBCC Teams Championship Finals Criteria and Rules

6. DRESS CODE

- a. Dress standard will be as deemed acceptable by licensed premises
- b. All players must wear identical team shirts identifying the club they represent

7. SUBSTITUTES

- a. The use of substitutes is NOT allowed in this competition

8. PLAYER BEHAVIOUR

- a. Players and captains are required to adhere to the ABSC Code of Ethics and ABSC Social Media Policy available to read on www.snookercc.com (excluding the non-consumption of alcohol clause)
- b. Players and captains are required to adhere to the SBCC Etiquette guidelines, available to read on www.snookercc.com
- c. Players must comply with any requirements and/or directions of the management and staff at the venue (i.e. the licenced club where games are played)

9. TEAM FEES

- a. Team registration fee \$75.00
- b. Player registration fee of \$25.00
- c. Player membership fee maybe applicable if not a current financial member, fees are outlined on player registration application form
- d. All fees will be invoiced to the member club who will be responsible for payment of registration fees

10. DISCLAIMER

- a. SBCC prepares competitions for all members, by participation you automatically agree to all the terms in this document
- b. The SBCC Board reserves the right to alter any rules pertaining to this format at any time deemed necessary and appropriate in the best interest of its members and SBCC
