



MONDAY “A GRADE SUMMER COMP”

FORMAT 2024/25

1. TEAMS

- a. Any Member Club may enter a team after ensuring that all players are current financial members of the nominating Billiards & Snooker Club
- b. All players must be financial members of SBCC prior to playing and renew membership if due during the competition
- c. All players must remain financial members of nominating club to be eligible to play
- d. There is no limit to registered players per team
- e. New registrations will only be accepted up to the start of the last complete round
- f. Player registration/s must be received a minimum 5 days prior to scheduled play
- g. A player cannot be transferred from another team once they have played a game for another team

2. PLAYING FORMAT

- a. A competition round will be played each Monday night (excluding Public Holidays and other special events)
- b. All teams will compete in a round robin home & away format for the preliminary rounds
- c. Three (3) players are required to compete each round (match)
 - i. Two (2) players are required to constitute a match
 - ii. If a player forfeits his game the opposing team will be awarded the game win (1 point) and the three (3) frames which were required to win that game
 - iii. If a team forfeits all three (3) games the opposing players will each be awarded the game win (1 point) and the three (3) frames which were required to win that game
- d. Two games must be started by 6:30pm
 - i. If the third player is not present to start the game at 6:30pm a one (1) frame penalty is to be applied immediately and after each 15 minutes a subsequent frame penalty applied until the game has started or three (3) frames have been conceded.
- e. The competition will be Points Play
 - i. Each player will play 5 frames. 1 Point will be awarded for each frame won.
 - ii. All three (3) games must be completed.
 - iii. The team winning the most frames will be deemed the match winner
 - iv. All Finals will be played as “Match Play”, (Best of 5 frames format)
- f. All frames will be played off scratch.
- g. Captains can choose to play their team in any order.
- h. Only 1 (-40) player can play on the night in each team.
 - iii. SBCC may at any time change individual players handicaps.
- g. Frame scores must be recorded.

h. The Home team captain must ensure:

- i. That results are sent via text to the recorder (0404 553 043) on the evening of the match
- ii. To Email a Copy/Scan/Photograph of the official team sheet to the recorder within 24 hours of match at: results@snookercc.com

i. One (1) team point is offered to any team when all players present in identical team shirts identifying the club they represent.

3. PLAYING RULES

- a. Rules will apply to all games as per the OFFICIAL RULE BOOK of the AUSTRALIAN BILLIARDS & SNOOKER COUNCIL (Nov 2019 Handbook) and are to be observed at all times
- b. The "Foul and a Miss" rule will be imposed on all games in this competition. If deemed the player has not made a "fair" attempt to hit a ball-on the non-striker may elect to have the cue ball replaced only once per sequence.
- c. The "Mercy Rule" will be applied to all frames. Points difference required for the frame to be 'awarded' will be 3 snookers plus 1 point with each of the colours left on the table.
This rule can only be applied after there are no reds left on the table.
- d. **Venue Closures:** In the event a game cannot be finished due to the forceful completion and/or exiting a venue due to playing exceeding the venue trading hours, any frames not completed will be classed as a draw and both teams will receive 0.5 points for each outstanding frame.

4. FINALS

- a. A finals competition will follow the preliminary rounds
- b. SBCC Board will nominate which venue will be used for any of the Finals matches.
- c. To be eligible to play in the finals, an individual will need to have played a minimum of 40% or more matches within the preliminary rounds.

5. PRIZE-MONEY

- a. SBCC will provide a cash prize to the representing member clubs for this competition instead of individual trophies
- b. The Winning Team will be rewarded with 60% and the runner up 25% of the prize pool
- c. The prize pool will be determined by the player registrations fees less referee fees where required.

6. DRESS CODE

- a. **Preliminary rounds:**
 - i. Dress standard will be as deemed acceptable by licensed premises.
 - ii. All players must wear identical team shirts identifying the club they represent.
- b. **Finals:**
 - i. All players must wear identical team shirts identifying the club they represent.
 - ii. Players must wear enclosed shoes, however we encourage all players to wear long pants.

7. SUBSTITUTES

- a. As there is no limit to how many players a team can register, players will only be able to play in the team they are registered.

8. REFEREES

- a. Where available referees will be requested to officiate in Grand Finals only and will be paid for their service

9. PLAYER BEHAVIOUR

- a. Players and captains are required to adhere to the ABSC Code of Ethics available to read on www.snookercc.com (excluding the non-consumption of alcohol clause)
- b. Players and captains are required to adhere to the SBCC Etiquette guidelines, available to read on www.snookercc.com
- c. Players must comply with any requirements and/or directions of the management and staff at the venue (i.e. the licenced club where games are played)

10. TEAM FEES

- a. Team registration fee \$100.00
- b. Player registration fee of \$30.00
- c. Player membership fee may be applicable if not a current financial member. Fees are outlined on player registration application form
- d. All fees will be invoiced to the member club who will be responsible for payment of registration fees

11. DISCLAIMER

- a. SBCC prepares competitions for all members. By participation you automatically agree to all the terms in this document
- b. The SBCC Board reserves the right to alter any rules pertaining to this format at any time deemed necessary and appropriate in the best interest of its members and SBCC
